A. INSTRUCTION TO TENDERERS

1. Technical bid should accompany EMD of **Rs. 5,000.00** in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of KIOCL Limited, Panambur.
2. Tenders will be received up to 15:00 hrs. on **30.11.2010** and the Technical bid will be opened on the same day at 15.30 hrs. Bids received late are liable for rejection. The price bids of techno commercially accepted offers will be opened on a specified date which will be communicated to the bidders for participation to witness the same.
3. Tenderers have to acquaint themselves with the conditions prevailing at site, before submitting the tenders.
4. Tenderers shall furnish their quotation in the schedule enclosed to the bid documents. Quotations should be written in both words and figures.
5. Owner/Engineer reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.
6. Owner/Engineer reserves the right to award part of the work or the whole, as may be considered necessary.
7. Tenders received late are liable for rejection.
8. Tenders submitted without EMD will not be considered.

B. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The work shall generally be governed by KIOCL Ltd's General Conditions of Contract (TS/B/KIOCL/QF-31/REV-1) which is available for reference in Projects Office on all working days.
2. Scope of work in this contract broadly covers the following.
 - (a) **As per schedule of work enclosed.**
3. The quantities given in the schedule of items are approximate and may vary or some of the items may not be executed. No claim by the contractor on account of variations, omissions and modifications will be entertained.

4. No escalation is admissible on any account whatsoever.
5. Rates quoted against schedule items shall include all materials, labour, machinery expenses and hire charges, taxes, royalties, transport, maintenance incidents, enabling works etc. based on the conditions mentioned herein. Unless otherwise specified in the tender schedule the rates for all items will be deemed to include all leads, lifts and decents in the work.
6. The work executed shall be maintained in good condition for a period of **NIL MONTH** from the date of completion including repair required if any at contractor's cost. If the contractor fails to fulfill his obligation during the maintenance period, the same shall be got done by the owner at contractor's risk and cost.
7. (a) 10% of the value of work shall be deducted and retained till the completion of work.
(b) Initial Security Deposit of 3% of the value of work shall be adjusted immediately after the placement of order. EMD shall be adjusted against the initial Security Deposit. The balance 7% shall be recovered from each running bill. The Security Deposit shall be refunded after successful completion of maintenance period, as applicable.
8. Any damage to the company's property caused by the contractor during the execution/maintenance of work shall be charged to the contractor and the amount of damage shall be left to the sole discretion of the Engineer.
9. Statutory deduction towards all applicable taxes shall be made as per rules.
10. Royalties if any for materials applicable shall have to be paid by the contractor.
11. All safety appliances like safety belt, helmets etc. have to be provided by the contractor to all his workers and supervisors. None of the workmen without safety appliances shall be allowed to work at heights.
12. The contractor shall abide with all the provisions contained in Factories Act and Rules/Regulations/Bylaws/Orders made thereunder.
13. The contractor should obtain Insurance Policy to cover the risk of the labourers under Workmen Compensation Act and should be produced before starting the work.
14. Time of completion and Liquidated Damages :

The entire work under this Contract shall be completed within **ONE MONTH w.e.f, 1st January 2011** from the date of issue of Work/Repair/Maintenance Order. If the contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated completion time, the contractor shall pay to owner as liquidated damages for such default, for every day which shall elapse between the date prescribed thereof and the actual date of completion of the scope of work, the amounts determined on the basis of the percentage of the value of the work as specified herein.

Delay of 1st 20 days 0.1% per day
Delay of next 20 days 0.15% per day

subject to a maximum of 5% of the value of the work. The Owner/Engineer has the discretion to reduce or waive the Liquidated Damages.

15. Our Company comes under Factories Act, Rules, Regulations, byelaws and orders made thereunder. Hence the Contractors must abide by the same.
 - (i) No persons shall be employed without Initial Training on Safety as per vocational Training Rules.
 - (ii) Contractor must immediately after deploying the Contract Workers, get their initial Medical Examination done at Company Hospital/Company recognised Hospital. The expenditure towards Medical Examination of Contract Workers shall be borne by KIOCL Ltd.
 - (iii) A supervisor with experience should be deployed to ensure that the contract workers work safely and in accordance with all the provisions of Factories Act, Rules, Regulations, Byelaws and orders made thereunder.
16. The Contractor shall be responsible for all the safety measures as per the rules in the interest of safety of all the labourers working under him. Necessary safety appliances shall be provided to all the labourers at Contractor's cost.

Wherever it is observed that the contractor has not provided safety appliances to the workers engaged by him, the Management reserves the right to issue the necessary safety appliances to his workers on cost recoverable basis.

17. The Bids shall be valid for a period of three months from the due date of submission of the bid.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The following are the specifications proposed for the Periodic Medical Examination of the employees due on 2010 (January 2011).
 - a) The Agency to conduct PME should be a reputed occupational health agency and “ISO accreditation” or any other relevant accreditation is preferred.
 - b) The agency to conduct PME by an occupational health specialist with requisite qualification. The certificate of “Associate fellow of Industrial health” (AFIH) is preferred.
 - c) The Agency conducting PME should have sufficient experience in conducting PMEs in major industries – proof to be furnished.
 - d) The Agency conducting PMEs should have standard equipments with up to date proper and valid calibration for lab tests, audiometric, spirometry, ECG etc. – proof to be furnished.
 - e) The reports of specialized tests like X – ray, ECG, audiometry, spirometry etc., to be certified by concerned specialists only.
 - f) The investigation reports to be submitted both in soft and hard copies i.e. of Lab tests, ECG, audiometry, spirometry X- ray etc.
 - g) Form No. 16 certified by “Certifying surgeon of Factory Health Services” to be submitted both in soft and hard copies.
 - h) General Medical Examinations format with details of History, General physical Examination, anthropometry, Eye, Ear and Systemic examination to be submitted including Employees photo, listed staff No. wise both in soft and hard copies.
 - i) Overall analysis of health of employees in the form of compiled data/ charts/ tables etc., to be submitted both in hard and soft copies listed Staff No. wise.
 - j) The PME should be completed within stipulated time agreed and all the reports to be delivered to the First Aid & OHS Cell, Mangalore at the agency’s cost.
2. The payment will be at the agreed consolidated rate per medical examination and shall be on submission of the comprehensive occupational health status report and against submission of Form No. 16 certified by “Certifying surgeon of Factory Health Services”. Additional payments per institutions scheduled rates will be paid for additional diagnostics advised by the examining doctor based on necessity (based on symptoms/clinical examination/basic diagnostic results) on production of documentary proof.
3. Facilities provided by KIOCL Ltd:
 - i) Service of a qualified male nurse to aid the medical examiner.
 - ii) Fully equipped First Aid Center, which can be used as an examination room.
 - iii) Subsidised canteen facility during the examination process at KIOCL Ltd.
 - iv) Lodging and boarding: Lodging and boarding (food includes only vegetarian) will be arranged by KIOCL Ltd. for the Doctor and his team within 5 to 8 Kms. from the site. The cost towards boarding and lodging will be borne by KIOCL Ltd.
 - v) To & Fro travel charges: To & fro travel (by road/taxi only) charges for the doctor and his team from his head quarter to the site will be borne by KIOCL Ltd. subject to production of actual bills.
 - vi) Local conveyance at KIOCL Ltd. (camp place): Local conveyance (camp place) for the doctor and his team will be provided by KIOCL Ltd.
 - vii) Services of a person from Personnel department will be deputed from the Company for streaming the employees of medical test.

4. Document proof of Occupational health diploma or degree should be submitted for verification.
5. Doctor with this qualification must be in the team of examiners.
6. TAXES & DUTIES: This clause shall be applicable notwithstanding any other clause related to taxes & duties mentioned elsewhere in this tender document:
 - b. The rate quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes applicable for this work except Service Tax.
 - c. The applicable service tax will be reimbursed on production of proof of remittance of Service Tax as per Rule 6(1) of Service Tax Rules for those contractors who do not have Service Tax Registration number.
 - d. For contractors who are having Service Tax registration no., the Service tax will be paid extra based on claim of the contractor. However, the contractor shall produce a copy of half yearly return of Service tax filed at the office of the Superintendent of Central Excise. The final bill/SD will be released after production of the copy of half yearly return.
